Dear “Not Fully Vaccinated” Australians, Thou shall not ... Fourteen New Rules for Healthy People

If you are over the age of 16 years and are “not fully vaccinated” you cannot visit another person’s place of residence, except in limited circumstances, says the New South Wales Government.

Visiting family and friends

Place of residence

The rules for visiting a place of residence have changed.

1. "If you are over the age of 16 years and are not fully vaccinated you cannot visit another person's place of residence, except in limited circumstances."
2. "If you are not fully vaccinated you cannot visit a gym or indoor recreation facility."
3. "If you are not fully vaccinated you cannot visit a recreation facility."
4. "If you are not fully vaccinated you cannot visit a public swimming pool, either indoor or outdoor."
5. "If you are not fully vaccinated you cannot attend an outdoor event."
6. "If you are not fully vaccinated, you can only visit critical retail premises."
7. "If you are not fully vaccinated you cannot visit a retail hairdresser, beauty salon or massage premises."
8. "If you are not fully vaccinated you cannot visit a hospitality venue except for take away."
9. "If you are not fully vaccinated you cannot visit an entertainment facility."
10. "If you are not fully vaccinated you can only attend a small wedding service."
11. "If you are not fully vaccinated you can only attend a small funeral or memorial service."
12. "If you are not fully vaccinated you cannot attend a place of worship."
13. "If you are not fully vaccinated you can only travel in a vehicle with people you live with"
14. "If you are not fully vaccinated you cannot take a holiday outside the local government area you live in."

- if any of the visitors at a place of residence who are aged over 16 years are not fully vaccinated.

A person who is required to be fully vaccinated to enter premises must:

- Carry their vaccination evidence
- Produce the evidence if requested to do so by a police officer or authorised officer.

If you are required to be fully vaccinated to enter a premises, you may be asked to produce your vaccination evidence by the occupier. We encourage you to comply with an occupier's request.

You do not have to produce your vaccination evidence to the occupier, however, the occupier may refuse entry to you if you do not produce your vaccination evidence.

People who provide an emergency service are able to enter premises if they are not fully vaccinated and are at the premises to provide an emergency service.

Rules for fully vaccinated people in NSW

What does “not fully vaccinated” mean and what is a Vaccine?

The United States CDC is treating the term “fully vaccinated” as a moving target (<https://theexpose.uk/2021/10/26/cdc-director-says-definition-of-fully-vaccinated-may-change-to-include-booster-shots/>) so in the event that the government of New South Wales does the same, we have captured a screenshot of their definition of “fully vaccinated” and “not fully vaccinated.”

fully vaccinated people so long as they visit certain businesses with a fully vaccinated member of your household.

For people over the age of 16 who are not fully vaccinated, more rules and restrictions apply.

You are not fully vaccinated if you have had:

- only one dose of a COVID-19 vaccination or
- no doses of a COVID-19 vaccination.

The Australian Therapeutic Goods Association (“TGA”) states: “Vaccines are medicines that protect you against specific diseases.”

What is a vaccine?

Vaccines are medicines that protect you against specific diseases, such as measles, influenza (flu) or whooping cough. Vaccination is the act of receiving a vaccine, which in most cases involves having the vaccine injected with a needle.

Vaccines can contain:

- dead viruses or bacteria
- severely weakened forms of viruses or bacteria
- small, purified components of viruses or bacteria.

After receiving a vaccine, your body's immune system can remember the virus or bacterium and fight off an infection much more effectively than if it was encountering the virus or bacterium for the first time.

The TGA goes on to say: “There are some people in the community who cannot be vaccinated because they are too young or too sick. Widespread vaccination helps protect these people by making it more difficult for a disease to spread.”

As of 25 June 2021, since the pandemic began one person below the age of 30 has died due to Covid related causes.

(168 and 183 per 100,000 people, respectively) were higher than all other age groups, except 85 years and over (279 per 100,000). Between January and 16 June 2021, there were 187 cases among young people aged 15 to 24, making up 9.7% of the total 1,929 cases during this period. In 2021, across all 5-year age groups in the population, rates of confirmed cases have been highest among those aged 30–34, followed by those aged 35–39, and those aged 25–29.

- **Of the 910 COVID-19-related deaths in Australia since the pandemic began 1 was in the 20–29 age group.**
- In July–August 2020, among young people aged 13–17, 42% said the pandemic and response had negatively affected their social connectedness, a drop from 70% in April 2020. The proportion for young people in Melbourne was higher, at 55%, but still lower than April levels. The easing of restrictions across much of the country at the end of June 2020 brought more structure and connectedness to young people’s lives.

And, as stated on the Department of Health’s website (<https://www.health.gov.au/news/first-covid-19-vaccinations-in-australia>), “the first people to receive the vaccines will be priority groups who are at a higher risk of COVID-19.”

A new study from Massachusetts (<https://www.thailandmedical.news/news/harvard-and-madph-study-shows-that-delta-sub-variant-ay-25-is-transmitted-by-fully-vaccinated-individuals-and-causes-breakthrough-infections>), USA, in a county with a high rate of vaccination, 68%, found 84% of reported cases, most of whom were symptomatic, were “fully vaccinated” individuals.
