These interest rate restrictions changed on Tuesday

From Tuesday, restaurant restrictions will be eased. Many areas again have access to gyms and a swimming pool.

Some of the restrictions will be lifted as early as Tuesday, as previously outlined by the government and regional authorities. Nationwide, easing of restaurant restrictions will take effect nationwide on Tuesday, as outlined by the government's coronation ministerial working group last Thursday.

The opening of customer facilities, such as gyms, and the easing of assembly restrictions are decided regionally by regional government agencies and municipalities. Last week, many regional government agencies outlined the opening of closed facilities and the easing of restrictions on public events.

At least these restrictions will change.

1. Food restaurants may be open at a later date

From Tuesday, restaurants will be open until 9pm instead of the current evening. The drinking of alcohol will end no later than 8 p.m.

The doors of the bars, on the other hand, will continue to close at 6 pm.

In the restaurants, hygiene obligations and restrictions on seating and customer seats will remain the same. The corona passport will remain in the buckle until 15 February, ie restrictions cannot be circumvented with the corona pass until mid-February.

2. Sports, hobby and recreation facilities are opening up in many areas

In Uusimaa, customer facilities such as gyms and swimming pools are allowed to open their doors to customers. The Regional State Administrative Agency of Southern Finland outlined the lifting of the closure of sports, leisure and recreation facilities last Friday. Avi made a formal decision on the matter on Monday.

In Kymenlaakso, gyms, swimming pools and facilities used for individual sports will open to the public on Thursday.

In Southwest Finland and Satakunta, the decision to close the customer premises was already revoked on Saturday.

In Kanta-Häme some of the customer facilities, such as gyms, swimming pools and indoor playgrounds, opened as early as Friday.

The Regional State Administrative Agency of Eastern Finland, for its part, overturned the

3. Restrictions on public events are relaxed

From Tuesday, public events and general meetings for up to 50 people can be held indoors in Uusimaa if participants have a designated seating area. Restrictions on gatherings include theater and cinema screenings, concerts and sports matches.

Since Saturday, half of the number of participants allowed to be admitted to the public has been able to attend public events in Southwest Finland and Satakunta.

In Kanta-Häme, the restrictions on public events remain unchanged. Public events and general meetings for up to 10 people can be held indoors and up to 50 people outdoors.

In Northern Ostrobothnia, the ban on interiors, public events and general meetings ended on Monday.

4. Internal border control shall end

Border checks on passenger traffic between Finland and the EU and Schengen countries will end. The government decided to abandon internal border controls restored at the end of December last Thursday. Restrictions on external border traffic, on the other hand, will continue until 14 February.

Those arriving in Finland from outside the EU and Schengen area are required to have a certificate for a full series of vaccinations or for coronary heart disease within six months. In addition, a negative test result less than two days old is required. The requirement applies to those born in 2006 or earlier.

Certificates are not required from Finnish citizens, foreigners permanently residing in Finland, or persons whose entry is based on a necessary reason.

However, all passengers arriving in Finland are subject to the requirements of the Infectious Diseases Act for the presentation of certificates and decisions made by regional administrative agencies on compulsory health examinations.

Immigrants must have a vaccination certificate or a certificate of coronary heart disease or a negative test result less than three days old.
