MANILA, Philippines — The government's pandemic task force Inter-Agency Task Force for the Management of Emerging Infectious Diseases (IATF), has recommended wearing face masks outdoors voluntarily, Malacañang announced on Wednesday.

Press Secretary Trixie Cruz-Angeles said wearing face masks was recommended as "optional" in open spaces, non-crowded outdoor areas with good ventilation.

However, senior citizens and immunocompromised individuals are "highly encouraged" to continue wearing their masks.
