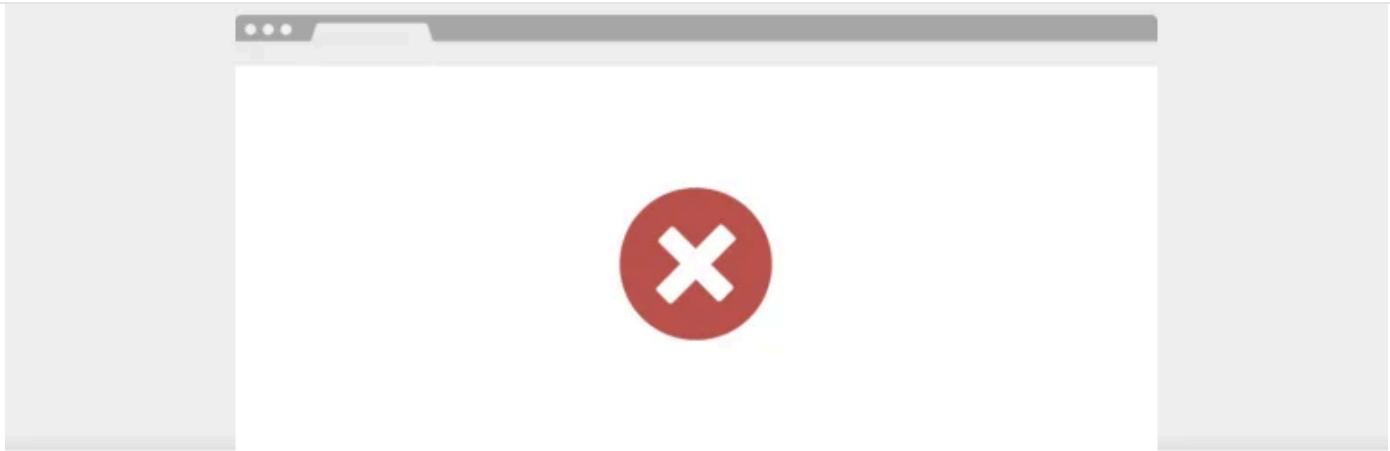

The official website of the British police – Police-uk – has started blocking access from outside the UK, the EU, but also Australia and the US, at a time of great tension in the UK. This move follows a series of crackdowns, also online, that the British police are carrying out after the clashes of the past few days. There is no official news, but the site was probably targeted by hacker attacks that convinced the authorities to take the website off line temporarily for users outside the UK.

Restricted access from the European Union, United States and beyond

Users located in the European Union – but actually also from other areas such as Australia and the United States – who try to access the British police site now face an IP blocker, which prevents them from viewing or interacting with the site. This measure has raised concerns among non-UK residents who may need to access UK police services or information while abroad.

Response to Potential Threats

The decision to restrict access to UK IP addresses only appears to be a precautionary measure to address cyber security concerns. Although no official explanation has been given, the block seems to be an attempt to reduce the risk of further attacks or disruptions, thus protecting the integrity of the site.
